Mental Health Services Act
Prevention and Early Intervention Statewide Programs
Notice of 30 Day Comment
July 13, 2010

Lake County Mental Health (LCMH) is announcing the 30 day comment period from July 17 – August 16, 2010 for the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Statewide Programs Assignment Agreement for fiscal years 2008–2012. LCMH proposes to 1) join the California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA), an Independent Administrative and Fiscal Governments Agency focused on the efficient delivery of California Mental Health Projects, and 2) assign Statewide PEI funds for fiscal years 2008–2012 to the Department of Mental Health (DMH) to fund the contract between DMH and CalMHSA.

As a member of CalMHSA, LCMH will work with other member counties to jointly develop, fund, and implement mental health services, projects, and educational programs at the state, regional, and local levels. The Statewide PEI funds being assigned are intended to fund the following initiatives: Suicide Prevention, Student Mental Health, and Stigma and Discrimination Reduction.
