Lake County Mental Health (LCMH) is announcing the public hearing for the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) plan and budget for fiscal year 2009 – 2010. This meeting is scheduled for 12:00pm on Monday, April 13, 2009 at the Lake County Mental Health Clinic located at 991 Parallel Drive, Lakeport, in the large conference room.

MHSA provides an array of services to those persons of all ages who suffer from, or are at risk of, severe mental illness. These services include full service partnerships with individual consumers in need of intensive, “whatever it takes” services to avoid hospitalization, incarceration or homelessness due to mental illness. MHSA provides general services such as the adult and transitional age drop-in centers as well as mental health services for those involved with the jail or juvenile justice systems. Others benefit from outreach and engagement to those populations deemed underserved or not served by traditional mental health services. PEI will provide Mental Health Prevention and Early Intervention services throughout Lake County.
