Lake County Behavioral Health is announcing the 30-day comment period from June 18 – July 17, 2013 for the FY 2013/14 Annual Update to the Mental Health Services Act Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan.

The public hearing will be held at 4:00pm on Thursday, July 18, 2013 at the Historic Courthouse Museum located at 255 North Main Street in Lakeport.

The Mental Health Services Act has been providing funding to Lake County since 2005 to support a variety of initiatives to assist consumers and their families in the local community. These initiatives include direct services and supports as well as prevention and early intervention programming. Input from consumers and their families, partner agencies, and representatives from cultural and ethnic populations in Lake County aided in the development of these programs through the Community Program Planning process as required by the Act. At this time, stakeholder participation is requested to provide input on proposed changes to the FY 2013/14 Annual Update.
