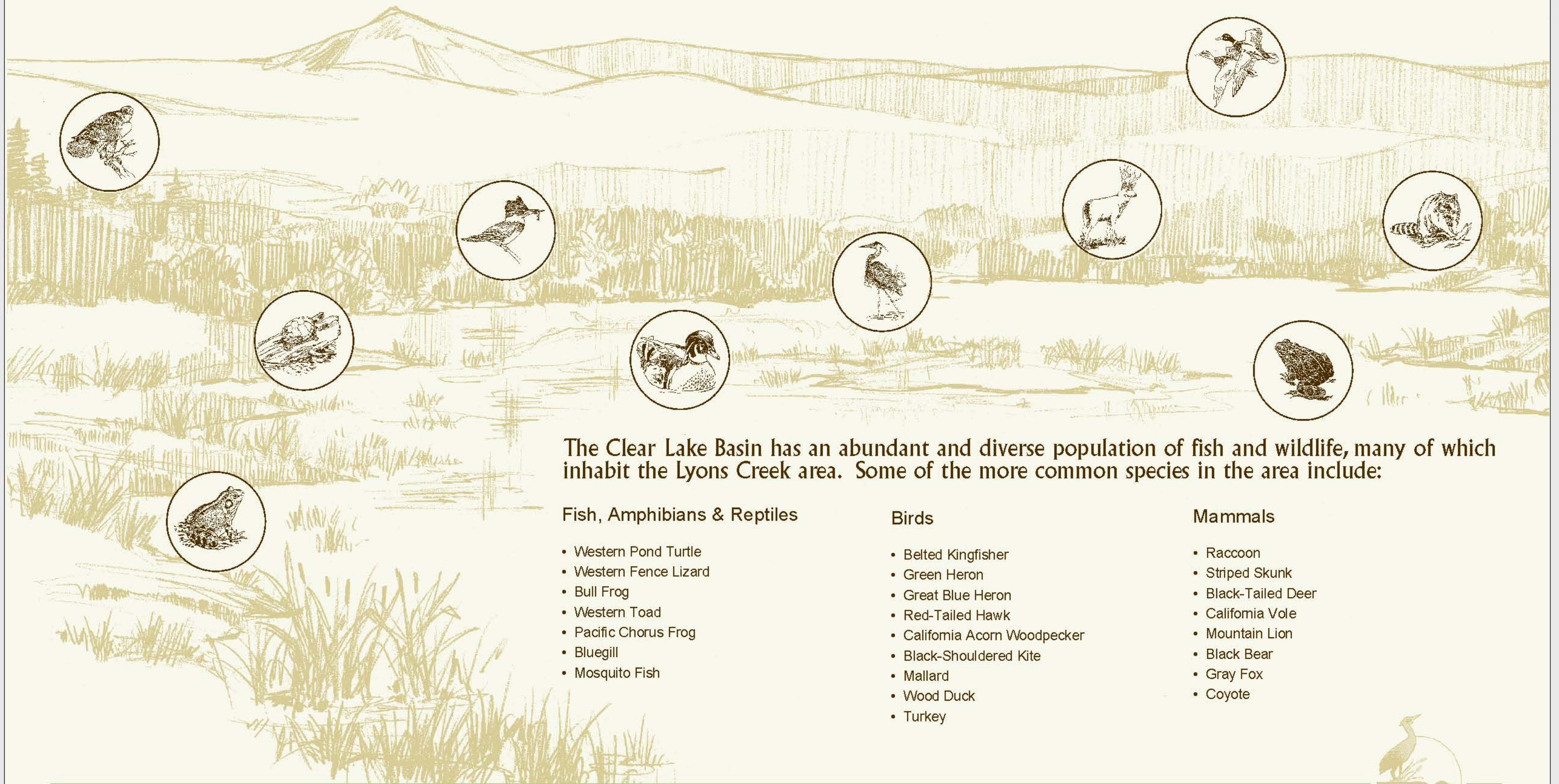


Wildlife in the Clear Lake Basin
