

Employee Certification of Vaccination Status

The County of Lake continually strives to maintain a workplace that is free from recognized hazards and to promote the health and well-being of our employees and those who visit our facilities. As part of this effort, the County has implemented numerous safety protocols consistent with state, CDC, and Cal/OSHA guidance. Effective June 17, 2021, employees who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 will be exempt from the masking protocols. For this reason, if you are fully vaccinated and would like to be exempt from wearing a face-covering pursuant to Cal/OSHA's rules, you must provide HR with your COVID-19 vaccination status.

For purposes of this certification, you are considered "fully vaccinated" two weeks after completing the second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine (e.g., Pfizer or Moderna) or two weeks after receiving a single dose of a one-dose vaccine (e.g., Johnson & Johnson/Janssen). If you decline to provide information about your vaccination status, we will be required to assume you are unvaccinated and you will have to continue to wear a mask per OSHA guidelines, unless you have an exemption outlined in the COVID-19 protocol.

Once your form has been received by HR, fully vaccinated employees may stop wearing face-coverings.

Please remember all employees and members of the public should be treated with respect regardless of their vaccination status. Also, be aware that many people may wish to continue wearing masks despite having been vaccinated. Wearing a mask is not indicative of a person's vaccination status. Retaliation against employees or the public based on their vaccination status, perceived status, or for wearing face coverings will not be tolerated.
