**Meeting called to Order 5:05pm**

**Approve by Roll Call Vote:**

May 23, 2022 meeting minutes were approved by roll call vote.

**Old Business**

- Request to clear Scotts Creek –Lake County Water Resources will need “right of entry” forms signed by property owners adjacent to Scotts Creek to access the creek bed. Will need to contact William Fox, Lake County Water Resources regarding the form and provide APN’s

**New Business**

- New Use Permits – Council Member Terre Logsdon reported no new Use Permits.
- City of Lakeport South Main Annexation update – Going to a vote on the November general election ballot for those registered voters in that area

- Scotts Valley Groundwater Protection Committee – The Blue-Ribbon Committee met on May 25, 2022 and approved the E. Teasdale proposal as well as the updated AEM presented by William Fox. Steve Winant is now monitoring his well and Paul Harris, City of Lakeport has agreed to provide the City’s data monthly to determine if there is a connection to the Scotts Valley aquifer. William Fox, Lake County Water Resources will begin monitoring wells in Scotts Valley on July 25<sup>th</sup>; so far Steve Winant, Sky C. Hoyt and Rhonda Armstrong are participating in the well monitoring program. A well at the north end is needed; Jack Warner (Ranch) on Hendrix was recommended. Tom Nickle agreed to make contact. Lastly, the City of Lakeport is working on a drought mitigation plan to establish thresholds, for example, water only on certain day. The plan goes before the City Council on July 19, 2022.
- Multi-Tribal Fire Prevention Grant Application to CAL FIRE to support Scotts Valley Firewise Community – Terre Logsdon reported the grant award of approximately \$30K will be available in the Fall of 2022. The funds will be used primarily for reflective signs for residents
- Scotts Valley Firewise Committee update -Vice Chair Greg Scott – no report
- Broadband coverage for Scotts Valley - Susan Parker, Lake County CAO is the contact.
- South Cow Mountain Management Area Implementation Plan – it was recommended this item be moved to “Old Business”. Terre to contact Supervisor Scott for the BLM contact.
